Text: Psalm 16:1-6

"Preserve me, O God, for in you I take refuge. 2I say to the Lord, 'You are my Lord; I have no good apart from you.'

3As for the saints in the land, they are the excellent ones, in whom is all my delight. 4The sorrows of those who run after another god shall multiply; their drink offerings of blood I will not pour out or take their names on my lips. 5The Lord is my chosen portion and my cup; you hold my lot. 6The lines have fallen for me in pleasant places; indeed, I have a beautiful inheritance." Psalm 16:1-6

How to Find Fresh Joy

1. Discover the link between taking refuge in the Lord (Psalm 5:11, 18:2) and experiencing preservation/ guarding power (Psalm 37:28, 97:10)

2. Remember that all happiness/good gifts come from the Father (v.2)

"Do not be deceived, my beloved brothers. Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change." James 1:16-17

3. Celebrate role models: "the majestic ones in whom is all my delight" (v.3) [the true heroes] (Psalm 8:1, 8:9; Isaiah 33:21)




