Today's Message: The Puzzling Nature of Life Lived Under the Sun

Today's Text: Ecclesiastes 8:14-9:6

Ecclesiastes 8:14-17

"There is a vanity that takes place on earth, that there are righteous people to whom it happens according to the deeds of the wicked, and there are wicked people to whom it happens according to the deeds of the righteous. I said that this also is vanity. And I commend joy, for man has nothing better under the sun but to eat and drink and be joyful, for this will go with him in his toil through the days of his life that God has given him under the sun.

When I applied my heart to know wisdom, and to see the business that is done on earth, how neither day nor night do one's eyes see sleep, then I saw all the work of God, that man cannot find out the work that is done under the sun. However much man may toil in seeking, he will not find it out. Even though a wise man claims to know, he cannot find it out."

Ecclesiastes 9:1-6

"But all this I laid to heart, examining it all, how the righteous and the wise and their deeds are in the hand of God. Whether it is love or hate, man does not know; both are before him. It is the same for all, since the same event happens to the righteous and the wicked, to the good and the evil, to the clean and the unclean, to him who sacrifices and him who does not sacrifice. As the good one is, so is the sinner, and he who swears is as he who shuns an oath. This is an evil in all that is done under the sun, that the same event happens to all. Also, the hearts of the children of man are full of evil, and madness is in their hearts while they live, and after that they go to the dead. But he who is joined with all the living has hope, for a living dog is better than a dead lion. For the living know that they will die, but the dead know nothing, and they have no more reward, for the memory of them is forgotten. Their love and their hate and their envy have already perished, and forever they have no more share in all that is done under the sun."

Solomon has gone through his "bucket list" of pursuits by which he hoped to find meaning in life. Now, he reflects on some of the ultimate puzzlements in life, which cannot be answered when you live life as a "Under The Sun" proponent.

When you live "under the sun" (epicureanism) you give yourself to pleasure and the reality of God is inconsequential because God is ultimately undefinable.

PUZZLING ISSUES

1. Injustice (Ecclesiastes 8:14)

The response to injustice: "I commend joy, for man has nothing better under the sun but to eat and drink and be joyful." (v.15a)

2. Knowledge (Ecclesiastes 8:16-17)

"Though they know God's righteous decree that those who practice such things deserve to die, they not only do them but give approval to those who practice them." Romans 1:32

The willful rejection of divine revelation hardens the heart to the point that the person walking in disobedience takes delight in the sinfulness of others.

- 3. Death (Ecclesiastes 9:2-6)
 - The same event (death) happens to the righteous and the wicked, which is an intolerable evil to Solomon.
 - There is no hope beyond the grave.

THE BIBLICAL RESPONSE

"16 But when I thought how to understand this, it seemed to me a wearisome task,

17 until I went into the sanctuary of God; then I discerned their end. 18 Truly you set them in slippery places; you make them fall to ruin. 19 How they are destroyed in a moment, swept away utterly by terrors!"

"23 Nevertheless, I am continually with you; you hold my right hand. 24 You guide me with your counsel, and afterward you will receive me to glory.

25 Whom have I in heaven but you? And there is nothing on earth that I desire besides you.

26 My flesh and my heart may fail, but God is the strength of my heart and my portion forever."
Psalm 73:16-19, 23-26

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:


- 1. Solomon had come to the point in his life where the NBT (the next big thing) would not bring any satisfaction; therefore, he slips into deeper despair. Why is this the natural consequence of living the life of an epicurean?
- 2. Why does Solomon, in the light of injustice, turn to the "nothing better under the sun" argument of eating and drinking and being joyful? Is this a joy with content?
- . What is the result of not having a paradigm for truth?

"18 But the path of the righteous is like the light of dawn, which shines brighter and brighter until full day. 19 The way of the wicked is like deep darkness; they do not know over what they stumble." Proverbs 4:18-19

- 4. Give examples of the manifestation of Romans 1:32 in our culture today, i.e. people applauding those in error.
- . Solomon is continuously plagued with the thought of "the memory of them is forgotten" in the book of Ecclesiastes. How do you respond to that thought?


