Message: Enthralled (Captivated), Energized,

and Generationally Focused

Text: Psalm 145:1-8

"I will extol you, my God and King, and bless your name forever and ever. ²Every day I will bless you, and praise your name forever and ever. ³Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised, and His greatness is unsearchable. ⁴One generation shall commend your works to another, and shall declare your mighty acts. ⁵On the glorious splendor of your majesty, and on your wondrous works, I will meditate. ⁶They shall speak of the might of your awesome deeds, and I will declare your greatness. ⁷They shall pour forth the fame of your abundant goodness and shall sing aloud of your righteousness. ⁸The Lord is gracious and merciful, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love." Psalm 145:1-8

WE MAKE DISCIPLES

Meditation: Getting these truths deep in our thinking.

"Meditation is the deliberate, disciplined practice of focusing our attention on a truth or an aspect of reality-ideally, on the truth of the loving presences of Christ in and with us... Meditation means reflecting on truth, letting it sink in. Meditation involves silent musing...taking time daily to sit and ponder what is real." John White

2 Timothy 1:7 (Isaiah 40:28-31)

The Response: (vv. 4, 6a, & 7)

APPLICATION:

- 1. In the heart of a disciple there should be a compelling, invigorating desire to reach the next generation (v. 4) born of the knowledge of God.
- 2. Believers embrace the importance of fanning our commitment and love into a white hot flame (2 Timothy 1:6, Matthew 5:6) as opposed to the "I've got this..." mentality.
- 3. Our significance and calling is found in glorifying God and enjoying Him forever as we find ourselves in the gospel story of creation/fall/redemption/restoration.
- 4. There is a "before" and "after" biblical application of truth as seen in the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20). We should know, rejoice, and be enthralled and then "do the word."

It is not just a philosophy or a point of view or just a teaching that we take up and put into practice, but it is something infinitely more. There is a mighty power that enters into us. It is a life that is pulsating in us, and activity by the power of the Holy Spirit."
