Message: Getting it Right: The Church at Worship

1 Timothy 2:11-15

"11Let a woman learn quietly with all submissiveness. 12I do not permit a woman to teach or to exercise authority over a man; rather, she is to remain quiet. ¹³For Adam was formed first, then Eve; 14 and Adam was not deceived, but the woman was deceived and became a transgressor. 15Yet she will be saved through childbearing—if they continue in faith and love and holiness, with self-control." 1 Timothy 2:11-15

"The webbing together of God, humans, and all creation in justice, fulfillment, and delight is what the Hebrew prophets call Shalom. We call it peace but it means far more than mere peace of mind or a cease-fire between enemies. In the Bible, shalom means universal flourishing, wholeness and delight – a rich state of affairs in which natural needs are satisfied and natural gifts fruitfully employed, a state of affairs that inspires joyful wonder as its Creator and Savior opens doors and welcomes the creatures in whom he delights." 1. The Problem in 1 Timothy

In Ephesus, there were false teachers who gave themselves to meaningless discussions and advocated for abstinence in the area of marriage and food (1 Timothy 4:3). They ignored the gracious mercy and goodness of the Creator God who gave us all things for our enjoyment. The downgrading of marriage inevitably led to confusion in the church and the home regarding maleness and femaleness and a disparagement of the wonder and goodness of children.


