Message: ...and With Persecutions (Mark 10:30)

Mark 10:28-31

²⁸Peter began to say to him, 'See, we have left everything' and followed you.' ²⁹Jesus said, 'Truly, I say to you, there is no one who has left house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or lands, for my sake and for the gospel, ³⁰who will not receive a hundredfold now in this time, houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecutions, and in the age to come eternal life. ³¹But many who are first will be last, and the last first." Mark 10:28-31

In response to Peter's question, "what's in it for me/ us?" Jesus talks about the blessings of rich community, purposeful living, and eternal life; and also says there will be persecutions that believers face.

As we make application from this passage to our lives the question is: are Christians in America persecuted today? The answer is yes, but not at the same level or with intensity that other believers face in different parts of the world.

*The reality of Christ and his Word gives us a place to stand.

 If 2 Timothy 3:12 is true then no amount of PR is going to rescue the church from being thought of as out of step and backwards.
"But thanks be to God, who always leads us as captives in Christ's triumphal procession and uses us to spread the aroma of the knowledge of him everywhere. For we are to God the pleasing aroma of Christ among those who are being saved and those who are perishing. To the one we are an aroma that brings death; to the other, an aroma that brings life. And who is equal to such a task?" 2 Corinthians 2:14-16 (NIV)
