Message: The Revealed Secret of Flourishing, Joy, Perseverance and Hope for the Christian

Text: 1 Timothy 3:16

"Great indeed, we confess, is the mystery of godliness: He was manifested in the flesh, vindicated by the Spirit, seen by angels, proclaimed among the nations, believed on in the world, taken up in glory." 1 Timothy 3:16

A MYSTERY is that which was previously hidden or obscured, but is now revealed.

"...making known to us the MYSTERY of his will, according to his purpose, which he set forth in Christ as a plan for the fullness of time, to unite all things in him, things in heaven and things on earth." Ephesians 1:9-10

"To them God chose to make known how great among the Gentiles are the riches of the glory of this MYSTERY, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory." Colossians 1:27

"To me, though I am the very least of all the saints, this grace was given, to preach to the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ, and to bring to light for everyone what is the plan of the MYSTERY hidden for ages in God, who created all things..." Ephesians 3:8-9

"But blessed are your eyes, for they see, and your ears, for they hear. For truly, I say to you, many prophets and righteous people longed to see what you see, and did not see it, and to hear what you hear, and did not hear it." Matthew 13:16-17

3. Be astounded at our privileged position on this side of the glory, revelation, goodness and mercy of Jesus.

"Christ is like a river...A river is continually flowing, there are fresh supplies of water coming from the fountainhead continually, so that a man may live by it and be supplied with water all his life. So Christ is an ever-flowing fountain he is continually supplying his people, and the fountain is not spent. They who live upon Christ, may have fresh supplies from him to all eternity; they may have an increase of blessedness that is new, and new still, and which never will come to an end." Jonathan Edwards

4. Make it your endeavor to press from the foothills to the highest peak.

"It is not possible certainly just to sit down and will praise. Praise grows out of God-given perception of reality, a seeing God is infinitely good and infinitely good to me in Jesus Christ in every circumstance. To have that kind of praise, you need to take time, to wait upon the Lord in prayer and meditate upon His greatness and grace and the might of His kingdom."


