Message: Going Forward Under the Banner of the Gospel

of Grace

John 7:37-39 Text:

"<sup>37</sup>On the last day of the feast, the great day, Jesus stood up and cried out, 'If anyone thirsts, let him come to me and drink. <sup>38</sup>Whoever believes in me, as the Scripture has said, "Out of his heart will flow rivers of living water." <sup>39</sup>Now this he said about the Spirit, whom those who believed in him were to receive, for as yet the Spirit had not been given, because Jesus was not yet glorified." John 7:37-39

As the gospel of grace is continually understood and applied, our hearts are awakened to the grandeur and goodness of the triune God and we walk as resolute people who will joyfully give an account.

The gospel of grace which awakened and drew us to salvation is also that which builds individuals, families, churches and cultures. Therefore, we will be people who glory in the salvation found in Christ alone, as we live under the authority of Scripture.


